Summary:

An incomplete body. The skull and the upper vertebrae of the cervical spine were absent. The remains were totally skeletonized. There was some clothing with personal possessions.

The person was male, aged between 30 to 55 and measured 179.7+/-7.7 cm in height as estimated from anthropology data. There were no particular identifying features.

The comminuted fractures in right pelvic bone, sacrum, 5Th lumbar vertebra and the left sacro-iliac joint were due to a gunshot wound. The skull and the upper cervical spine were missing in this person. Therefore the probable cause of death was gunshot wound to the pelvis.

Cause of Death:

It is my determination that the cause of death in case number **GL01 / 760B** was:

Probably due to gunshot wound to the pelvis.





The person was male, aged between 30 to 55 and measured 179.7 ± 7.7 cm in height as estimated from anthropology data. There were no particular identifying features.

The comminuted fractures in right pelvic bone, sacrum and 5th lumbar vertebra and the left sacro-iliac joint were due to a gunshot wound. The ~~left~~ skull and the upper cervical spine were missing in this person. Therefore, the exact cause of death was not ascertained. The probable cause of death is in the person. Now, gunshot wound to the pelvis.
