SUMMARY:

In my opinion the cause of death of ZJ05B189 was gunshot and shrapnel wounds to the chest, abdomen and pelvis.

Comment:

The partial body of an adult male aged 27-66 years of undetermined stature showing skeletonization and adipocere formation. No clothes were present. No ante-mortem injuries present. Post-mortem injuries were present to the left humerus, right ulna, ribs and distal ends of both humeri. The fluoroscopic examination showed abundant metal foreign bodies to the arms, thorax, abdomen and pelvis. Jacket metal was retrieved from the right side of the pelvis. Shrapnel fragments were recovered from the thoracic spine, abdominal area and pelvis; the largest piece (5 x 2 cm) was recovered from the abdomen. Also present was a spring within the flesh of the left hip area and a cylindrical piece of material with a spiral pattern on it in the same area. This is in keeping with the components of an anti-personnel device, possibly a grenade. Disruption of the lower lumbar spine, sacrum and pelvis were present.

I am of the opinion that this male has been shot in the pelvis and received shrapnel wounds to the thorax, abdomen and pelvis. Part of a grenade entered the pelvic tissue on the left side and the explosion has disrupted the pelvic bones. A fragment of clear glass was also found in the pelvis. This was cuboid in appearance and may have originated from a window or even a glass component of a vehicle.

This formal report is based upon the autopsy report that I prepared at the time of my examination, and both reports truly and accurately reflect my findings.

There was disruption of the 4th/5th lumbar spine, sacrum (3 pieces) and left hemipelvis (3 pieces). The right inferior pubic ramus had a bone piece missing and with the body of the left hemipelvis there was a possible projectile with internal bevelling.

These were recovered from the upper thoracic spine (shrapnel); left hip area (grenade core); lumbar spine (shrapnel); right pelvis (bullet jacket fragment); flesh of the left hip (spring); left of pelvis (metal); lower abdomen (shrapnel 5 x 2 cm); pelvis (glass) and lower abdomen (shrapnel, 3 x 2 cm).






